The five day festival was fished by 175 anglers on Pollawyn, Jenny's, Trelawney, Trewaters, Porth and Bolingey Lakes. Throughout the week it was a very close competition with a number of anglers jostling for the top spots.

By the end of day four Kieron Rich and Phil Ringer were both tied on points but with an amazing haul of fish from Bolingey Lake on day five, Kieron took the win with a superior weight. Also with 36 points, Jamie Wilde finished in third position dropping 7 with a weight of 423lb 1oz.

## Preston Innovations Festival



11 - 15 October

Warm weather and sunny skies welcomed anglers on arrival for the biggest festival of the year, leading to the one day £25,000 Parkdean Masters Final. A total of 179 anglers qualified to fish the five day festival.

By the final day the competition was left wide open with potential for a number of anglers to finish the festival on maximum points with another section win. Lee Kerry took the 2010 victory in what was the highest ever scoring line up for the Parkdean Masters Final. Tying with Lee Kerry on 36 points, Alan Scotthorne dropped 5 to finish in second place. In third place was Andy Power with 35 points and a better dropped score of 8.

## 2010 Parkdean Masters Winner, Lee Kerry, shares his double victory story

Lee Kerry celebrated a double victory and recorded the best match weight in the eleven year history of the event. After collecting a cheque for £25,000 and the Parkdean Masters trophy, Lee celebrated his win with a traditional dive into Jenny's Lake.

The Preston Innovations Festival.

As usual the fishing at White Acres did not disappoint. My week started off slowly with 63lb of Carp from Bolingey Lake. The next three days saw section wins on three different Carp lakes, including Pollawyn, Twin Oaks and Trewaters. The Carp responded really well to my tactics on a method feeder using the White Acres' 2mm pellets soaked down with a 6mm pellet on the hook. I also caught a lot of fish from the short pole line too. Regularly feeding meat throughout the day gave me the chance to catch a few Carp in the final hours. The last few days of the festival saw me at Porth Reservoir where a good draw on peg 89 produced some fantastic waggler fishing. My 20lb of Skimmers was enough to secure my third lake win of the week and the top spot in the festival with a maximum 36 points.

The Parkdean Masters Final.

My win in the Preston Innovations Festival allowed me to draw first for the Parkdean Masters Final.

I was so excited. When I drew peg 16 on Jenny's Lake, I knew this could be my chance. I quickly established that F1's were lacking in number and decided to target Carp in the upper layers using a combination of worms and pellets. By the end of the match I had 14 big fish and a record breaking final weight of 99lb 12oz. Absolutely over the moon with the result, I was little emotional as I packed away. I'd like to offer a massive thank you to all the staff at White Acres who make this sort of fishing festival possible. I have been fishing at White Acres for nearly eight years now and I look forward to going back every time! See you for some spring fishing.
