Last year I had quite a few carp from Jennys but I am only a novice, I have been s fishing widow for 25 years so now I know I cannot beat them so I intend to join them (two sons and a husband). I look forward to seeing you all later this year.

Clint... the best way to unhook a fish is with minimal handling in a soft fish friendly meshed landing net. If you support the net on your thighs the fish will lay in the bottom and you should be able to reach the barbless hook, use a disgorger if necessary. However your husband can unhook the fish in the match providing you hooked and landed the fish yourself.

We've decided to award you the ABU Garcia Suveran rod as this months star letter so it should help you in your quest to beat those sons and that husband of yours!

Clint... Python is an excellent tench water and in matches bags over 40lb have been caught. Fish tight to the nearside marginal cover and also to the island if you have a pole long enough. use smaller baits like tiny pieces of meat and smaller grains of corn over a bed of particle feed. There are some excellent bream and big skimmers all along the high bank on Pollawyn. Fishing the long pole with small pieces of meat, corn or chopped worm over caster should get you among them.

baits in the Thursday Rover match only. In the other matches surface baits are banned, you can also pleasure fish with surface baits using the controller rig.
