Martin Williams triumphed in the inaugural 72-entry **White Acres New Matchwinner Festival**, backed by tackle giants **Daiwa** to the tune of **£2000!** Martin's 35 points pocketed him a cool £1000 plus a **Daiwa Match Winner 811 pole worth £1250** and invitation to the **2003 Parkdean Masters**.
