FOR THE PLEASURE angler catching fish is easier if you target their natural feeding times. Make the effort to be up in time for first light you can enjoy a productive couple of hours before the rest of the world rises. Similarly the last couple of hours of

the day taking in dusk also coincides with a natural feeding spell and evening sessions can be very rewarding. These are quiet times of the day when the fish are not spooked and lose some of their natural caution. Besides what can be more rewarding

than watching the sun rise and set, while fishing!
