Help me to connect

Dear Clint,
I have just returned home after a fantastic two weeks holiday at the superb White Acres complex. I fished a feeder to one of the islands on Jenny's lake but only managed to connect with one in five bites. Even then half the fish were hooked just outside of the mouth. What was I doing wrong?

Clint... Try fishing with a short hook length (the minimum is 12 inches at White Acres) that might help you hook the fish in the mouth before they eject the bait. make sure the fish is on before striking by waiting for the tip to go round, that way you can be sure the bite is not a false one. If you still get liners cast a foot or two shorter until you start to get true bites.

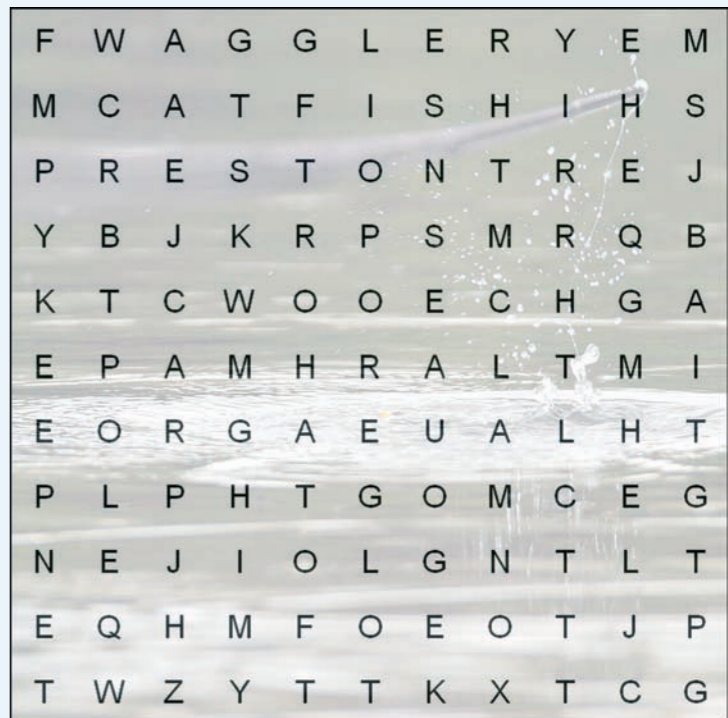
